The Indian Maritime University (IMU), a teaching-cum-affiliating University under the aegis of the Ministry of Shipping, Government of India, came into being existence on 14th November 2008 through an Act of the Parliament. It has all-India jurisdiction and is the only University in the country dedicated exclusively to the Maritime sector. IMU is committed to providing quality maritime education, training and research that are responsive to Industry needs. IMU has 18 Affiliated Institutes.

IMU is conducting Online CET in 36 cities across India from 2014 onwards for the Pre-sea courses and other Post Graduate Courses as given under:

Undergraduate programmes

- 4-Year B. Tech (Marine Engineering)
- 4-Year B. Tech (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering)
- 3-Year B. Sc (Nautical Science)
- 3-Year B. Sc (Ship Building & Repair) - This Programme is being conducted only in the Affiliated Institutes.
- 1-Year Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS) leading to B.Sc. (Applied Nautical Science)

Postgraduate programmes

- a) 2-Year M.Tech (Marine Engineering and Management)
- b) 2-Year M.Tech (Naval Architecture and Ocean Engineering)
- c) 2-Year M.Tech (Dredging and Harbour Engineering)
- d) 2-Year M.Sc (Commercial Shipping and Logistics)
- e) 2-Year MBA (Port and Shipping Management)
- f) 2-Year MBA (International Transportation and Logistics Management)

In this scenario, the Director General of Shipping had conducted a meeting with Indian Maritime University and representatives of Maritime Training Institutes (MTI) as in reference(1) cited with the proposal to have a common combined entry examination system at National level for all candidates who desire to pursue their career in Merchant Shipping to bring consistency in the system.

During the meeting, the Director General of Shipping made it very clear that qualifying of candidates seeking admission to Pre-sea courses approved by DG Shipping in a Common Entrance Test through IMU is mandatory.

The deliberations of the above meeting and IMU's readiness / willingness to conduct a common entrance test on all India basis was communicated to the Ministry of Shipping vide reference (3) cited.


Ministry of Shipping vide letter reference (4) cited directed IMU to conduct a Common Entrance Test on all India basis for admissions in DGS approved MTIs from the academic year 2020-21 onwards.

In view of the above, the proposed Common Entrance Test for admission to Marine related courses which is approved by Director General of Shipping will be conducted by end of May 2020 or 1st week of June 2020.

It is intimated that Affiliated Colleges of Indian Maritime University as well as the Colleges not affiliated to Indian Maritime University which are offering Pre-sea courses as approved by the Director General of Shipping have to **admit** mandatorily the **CET qualified candidates only**.
